
A Tenth Pass Leadership History of Kadanzer Weyr

The following is a generalized timeline of the leadership within Kadanzer Weyr since the Poisoning Event of mid-2850.09. The Weyr has seen a number of tragic events, and as a result, our leadership turnaround has been very high, even for a Weyr during a Pass. This comprehensive list utilizes information from archive stories, the timeline, published Wing Reports, and some archived CISs no longer available to the membership at large. A number of wingsecond positions remain undetermined; these are available for members who wish to backdate future personas.



FIRST, A NOTE ON LEADERSHIP RANK REQUIREMENTS:

Weyrwoman: the Weyrwoman of each Weyr is generally the rider of the oldest fertile queen; this determination is made by the dragons themselves, and a Weyrwoman only retires from her position due to death or her queen's infertility. Territoriality can prove an important influence; an example is Tanara's Renorath after the Poisoning. Given that she was already a fertile queen, she assumed the senior position among the Weyr's dragons, and later queens who transferred in were immediately subservient to her, even though they were both older and fertile.

Weyrwoman-second: the Weyrwoman-second of the Weyr is generally determined by the experience and seniority of the fertile queens; exceptions can be made for human political reasons, as this is more of human hierarchal position than a dragon concern, but if the issue comes down to inheritance of the Weyrwoman position, the junior queens will always sort themselves out in a hierarchy by age, regardless of rider age/experience/suitability. (As an example: in late 2855, Tanara was Weyrwoman, with Valenne as her Weyrwoman-second and Kira serving as her Weyrwoman-third. Yet if Tanara had been killed in Threadfall in early 2856, Kira would actually have inherited the Weyrwoman position at the Weyr over Valenne, since Nanyth would have been recognized by the other dragons as the eldest fertile queen.)

Weyrleader: the Weyrleadership of the Weyr is determined by which bronze flies the senior queen; after 2859.02, the mating flights of the senior queen will be limited to bronzeriders with proven leadership experience (such as have served as either wingseconds or wingleaders for more than a Turn).

Weyrsecond: the Weyrsecond is a dragonrider chosen by the Weyrleader to serve as his replacement until the next senior queen's flight, should the Weyrleader be killed or incapacitated. Weyrseconds are often other wingleaders with proven leadership histories, but it's not unusual for a Weyrleader to select a trusted senior wingsecond instead (F'lar and F'nor, or K'rel and D'zan are examples).

Flightleader: each Flightleader is chosen by his Weyrleader, and leads a Flight (a team of three combat Wings) during Threadfall if the Weyrleader is absent. Flightleaders must be wingleaders as well.

Wingleader: wingleaders are always bronzeriders, ones who have served at least two years as wingseconds. Wingleaders are demoted and promoted by their Weyrleader, in consultation with the affected Flightleader.

Wingsecond: wingseconds are bronzeriders or brownriders promoted or demoted by their Wingleader. Some rare blueriders served as wingseconds before the start of the Pass, but there are no bluerider wingseconds during a Pass (both because violation of inherent draconic hierarchy could cause fatal hesitation during Threadfall, and because blues rarely have excess necessary stamina required to deal with post-'Fall concerns, as well as to last extreme-condition Threadfalls.) After 2859.02, Weyrleader L'ars has made it mandatory for each Wing to have at least one bronzerider as one of its two wingseconds, and that all wingseconds must be at least 22 Turns of age, and have at least three years of combat experience in the regular combat Wings.

Weyrilingmaster: the Weyrilingmaster of the Weyr is promoted & demoted by the Weyrwoman. A Weyrilingmaster can ride any color of dragon, save for gold, and must have an impressive history in the combat Wings.

Weyrsecond/weyrlingassistants: weyrlingassistants can ride any color of dragon save for gold; the weyrlingassistant position is most often held by an experienced wingrider who has (or whose dragon has) been crippled to the extent that flying 'Fall is no longer an option; able-bodied riders are usually considered more valuable as wingriders during the Pass. A weyrlingassistant must have adequate combat experience to take on the responsibility of serving as a Weyrsecond for an entire weyrling class. After 2859.02, many experienced brownriders who lost their wingsecond positions were transferred into the Weyrling Wing, where their leadership experience would not be wasted,



THE WEYRWOMAN POSITION

Weyrwoman Charayn, rider of gold Eliath (2830 – 2850.09.15); Charayn served as Weyrwoman of Kadanzer for just under 20 Turns. She died in a mating flight accident on 2850.09.15, during the depths of the Poisoning event. Charayn was an earthy, intelligent woman with canny patience.

- Weyrwoman-second Reva, rider of gold Oriath. Reva was Charayn's Weyrwoman-second at the time of the Poisoning; she did not survive the Poisoning event. Reva was a quiet, no-nonsense woman who had a passion for painting.

Weyrwoman Tanara, rider of gold Renorath (2850.09.15 – 2857.09.24): Tanara was a journeywoman dragonhealer from High Reaches; she impressed her gold Renorath at Kadanzer on 2847.08.09. She served as Weyrwoman for over seven Turns, until her abduction by the Riverman (and subsequent death of gold Renorath) on 2857.09.24. Tanara was desperately young when she became Kadanzer's Weyrwoman, but she was gifted with a keen sense of diplomacy, and had a reputation for leaving people eager to help her, rather than feeling that they'd just been given an order.

- Weyrwoman-second Lauria, rider of gold Trinith (2851.01.01 – 2852.12.16). Although painfully young, Lauria's self-confidence and managerial skills led to her serving as Tanara's Weyrwoman-second while still only a weyrling, since there were no other golds at the Weyr at that time. She was replaced as Weyrwoman-second by Kira to allow her to focus on her weyrling training; unfortunately, it may have been too little, too late, as Lauria died in a tragic accident the day after graduation, an accident that also claimed the lives of Weyrleader K'rel and Wingleader J'ret. Lauria was notorious for giving more orders and assuming more responsibility in a situation than she had right to, and most of the Weyrfolk worried that she had undue influence on her brother, Weyrleader K'rel.
- Weyrwoman-second Kira, rider of gold Nanyth (2852.12.16 to 2854.02.05). Kira transferred to Kadanzer Weyr from Eastern Weyr on 2852.11.14, as soon as the gold-restriction on Kadanzer Weyr was lifted (the other Weyrs refused to allow golds to transfer until the person responsible for the 2850.09 Poisoning was found). Kira resigned and transferred back to Eastern Weyr on 2854.02.05 due to a lingering case of pneumonia, only to return to Kadanzer in early 2855 as Weyrwoman-fifth (she agreed not to displace Valenne, Darby, and Kielani to return to her old position.) She was killed on 2856.04.15 in the eruption of Kadanzer Mountain while overseeing the evacuation of supplies
- Weyrwoman-second Valenne, rider of gold Nicareth: (2854.02.05 – 2857.09.24) Valenne transferred to Kadanzer from Ista, because of irreconcilable differences with the Ista Weyrleadership. She became Tanara's Weyrwoman-second after Kira's short-lived 2854 transfer out of the Weyr for medical reasons; Valenne became Weyrwoman in 2857.09.24 upon gold Renorath's death.

Weyrwoman Valenne, rider of gold Nicareth (2857.09.24 – 2859.01.11): Valenne transferred to Kadanzer from Ista, after long-running disagreements with the Ista Weyrleadership. She became Tanara's Weyrwoman-second after Kira's transfer out of the Weyr for medical reasons in 2854; she became Weyrwoman in 2857.09.24 upon gold Renorath's death. In late 2858, Nicareth suffered a high fever after sustaining an injury while feeding; this fever resulted in her becoming infertile. When her infertility became manifest to the rest of the Weyr, Lybelle's Ihyanih assumed the position of senior queen; Valenne and Nicareth returned to Ista Weyr shortly thereafter.

- Weyrwoman-second Kielani, rider of gold Virankath (2857.09.24 – 2858.03.06); the daughter of a holdless troop, Kielani served for approximately five months after moving up from Weyrwoman-third before transferring out to Telgar Weyr in an effort to improve dragon bloodlines and shore up the level of leadership experience at Kadanzer.

- Weyrwoman-second Lybelle, rider of gold Ihyanith (2858.03.06 – 2859.01.11); transferred to Kadanzer from Telgar Weyr in exchange for Kielani, and was immediately posted as Weyrwoman-second due to her age and experience.

Weyrwoman Lybelle, rider of gold Ihyanith (2859.01.11 – present): Lybelle transferred to Kadanzer from Telgar Weyr on 2858.03.06 in a personnel swap for Goldrider Kielani, and immediately assumed the Weyrwoman-second position upon her arrival. When Nicareth proved infertile in early 2859.01, Ihyanith became the senior queen and Lybelle the Weyrwoman.

- Weyrwoman-second Dunia, rider of gold Nioranth (2859.01.11 – 2859.02.11); the daughter of Kadanzer Weyr's senior cook and of a dragonrider deceased in the Poisoning, Dunia is the sole native-born goldrider at Kadanzer. She served as Lybelle's first Weyrwoman-second for a month before being assumed lost *between* during an accident in Threadfall; at the time, Lybelle was making transfer plans to exchange one of her juniors for another older, more experienced woman to serve as her Weyrwoman-second.
- Weyrwoman-second Luka, rider of gold Savukath (2859.02.12 – 2859.02.14); a Cibolan native, young Luka became Lybelle's Weyrwoman-second upon Dunia's disappearance, and held the position for two days until Dunia's return from the Ninth Pass. Due to Luka's youth and inexperience, Lybelle was making arrangements to transfer Luka out in an exchange for an older, more experienced goldrider.
- Weyrwoman-second Dunia, rider of gold Nioranth (2859.02.14 – present); a timing accident during Threadfall sent Dunia *between* back to the Ninth Pass. Dunia lived in the Ninth Pass for ten Turns before returning to the Tenth Pass, bringing with her a number of other Ninth Pass survivors of the tsunami which destroyed the original Southern Weyr in 2440. She returned to the Tenth Pass three days after her initial disappearance, though she and her queen had gained ten Turns of maturity in the meantime.



THE WEYRLEADER POSITION

Weyrleader V'ron, rider of bronze Golteth: (2832 – 2850.09.15); V'ron was a steady Weyrleader to his weyrmate Charayn for nearly 20 Turns before their deaths during a Mating Flight accident on 2850.09.15.

- Weyrsecond J'riel, rider of bronze Brinnoth (tbd – 2850.09.13). Also the Wingleader of FlameWind, and served as V'ron's Weyrsecond for close to a decade before his death during the Poisoning.

Weyrleader K'rel, rider of bronze Asheth (2850.09.26 – 2853.01.01) transferred in from Telgar Weyr; won the Weyrleadership a little more than a sevenday later. Died on 2853.01.01 in a freak accident – when traveling to Telgar Weyr with sister Lauria and good friend J'ret, no one thought to check with Telgar for the weather. They arrived in the middle of a terrible blizzard, and collided with the mountains of their birthplace. J'ret alone survived the accident itself and a night left exposed on the mountain; died without regaining consciousness roughly a sevenday later.

- Weyrsecond D'zan, rider of brown Yoseth (2851.01.01—2853.01.01) Brownrider D'zan served as K'rel's senior wingsecond and Weyrsecond for most of K'rel's time as Weyrleader.

Weyrleader D'zan, rider of brown Yoseth (2853.01.01 – 2853.07.15) A reluctant Weyrleader, brownrider D'zan inherited the position after the death of Weyrleader K'rel. D'zan had the Flightleaders lead their Flights during Threadfall, and focused on the administrative efforts of the position while continuing to serve in reduced capacity as StormWind wingsecond.

- Weyrsecond R'mal, rider of bronze Udoth. (2853.01.01 – 2853.07.15) The younger half-brother of Lord Janol of Sunstone Hold, R'mal was searched by Landing Weyr while a fosterling in Landing's territory. He transferred to Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. While some might laugh at R'mal's pristine white gloves and lovely peach scarf, the bronzerider's logistical genius made him D'zan's first choice as Weyrsecond.

Weyrleader K'din, rider of bronze Dormiath (2853.07.15 – 2855.01.10) K'din was a childhood sweetheart of Weyrwoman Tanara; they were lovers for a time, before her dedication to the dragonhealer craft came between them. After the death of Weyrleader K'rel, D'zan learned of K'din's existence and purposefully recruited him to Kadanzer (the action was galvanized in part by D'zan's disgust at hearing some of the Weyr's bronzeriders plotting how to win Renorath's upcoming flight). K'din served as Weyrleader for two tours of duty before transferring himself back to the High Reaches; his transfer was controversial, as he transferred many of his closest wingmates and friends with him, including Leddi and gold Oroth. K'din's largest contribution to the Kadanzer Weyr was the formation of FireFlight, bringing the number of combat Wings up to twelve.

- Weyrsecond D'lin, rider of bronze Heveth. (2854.07.16-2854.13.28). D'lin came to Kadanzer from Ista Weyr after a venomous disagreement with Weyrleader R'sarn; he transferred back to Ista Weyr in 2854.13 for medical reasons. Father of Valenne's daughter Verlerinne. Served both as K'din's wingsecond and Weyrsecond for most of K'din's tour at the Weyr.

Weyrleader B'deras, rider of bronze Rath (2855.01.10—2856.01.01). B'deras transferred from Ista Weyr on 2852.04.15, along with his mother (Headsecond Bella) and sister (Craftmaster Giselle). All three saw unparalleled opportunities for advancement at the Weyr.

- Weyrsecond R'mal, rider of bronze Udoth (2855.01.10—2856.01.01). R'mal's logistical genius and smooth skills at diplomacy were put to use in a second tour of duty as Weyrsecond during B'deras's Turn as Weyrleader.

Weyrleader Th'rin, rider of bronze Wardreth (2856.01.01 – 2856.13.26). Originally from Telgar, Th'rin transferred to Kadanzer after the Poisoning, where he became a wingleader. He won the Weyrleadership from B'deras in 2856, and was Weyrleader during the chaos of the Weyr's relocation to its new site.

- Weyrsecond B'nalsh, rider of bronze Drannath (2856.01.01 – 2856.13.26). Raised at the healer's hall at Ista Hold and Searched by Ista Weyr, B'nalsh transferred to Kadanzer in early 2852, after the death of a woman he loved. Also served as wingleader in StormWind and FireStar.

Weyrleader A'nar, rider of bronze Garath (2856.13.26 – 2857.11.02) A'nar transferred to Kadanzer Weyr from Fort Weyr after the poisoning, to serve in the Weyrling Wing under B'loren; after B'loren's death, he took over leadership of the Weyrling Wing. He transferred out to a combat Wing 10 months later, taking over StarRacer upon the death of L'remi. He became Weyrleader in 2856, and implemented a non-traditional leadership strategy of giving up his wingleadership in order to devote his full attention to the Weyr's managerial needs. After a devastating 'Fall in 2857.02, in which a tornado claimed many lives, A'nar disbanded the StarFlight Wings, reshuffling the surviving StarFlight riders into the other nine combat Wings. His tenure saw the death of Weyrwoman Tanara, and was marked by intense personality conflict with new Weyrwoman Valenne.

- Weyrsecond W'hulf, rider of bronze Tolvumuth (2856.13.26 – 2857.11.02). Crippled by injuries sustained prior to the start of the Tenth Pass, W'hulf transferred to Kadanzer from Landing after the Poisoning and served for many Turns as a watchrider at Windsong Hold. After Lord Chyron's death in 2856.08, W'hulf transferred back to the Weyr to ride with the Queen's Wing. W'hulf was not a popular choice for Weyrsecond, given both his disabilities and his position outside of the regular combat Wings.

Weyrleader G'tin, rider of bronze Fordath (2857.11.02 – 2858.02.13). At the tender age of 17 Turns, G'tin was a surprise choice for Weyrleader, but had his Weyrwoman's backing after a Turn of strife between Valenne and A'nar. During his first Turn as Weyrleader, G'tin allowed the Flightleaders to lead during Threadfall, and spent much of his time shadowing each of the wingleaders in turn, flying every 'Fall and using each as a learning opportunity. A largely passive Weyrleader during this time, G'tin was struggling to earn the respect of his wingleaders and wingriders. When Wingleader L'rian died in Threadfall on 2858.11.10, however, G'tin overrode the advice of his wingleaders and named himself Wingleader of SkyTamer Wing, openly challenging any who disagreed with him to prove themselves right by winning Nicareth's upcoming Mating Flight. When Fordath won Nicareth a second time on 2858.11.22, G'tin and Valenne both saw his victory as a validation of his right to serve as Weyrleader. His second term in office proved short, as Nicareth proved infertile, and Ihyanith not quite so fond of Fordath as Nicareth had proven.

- Weyrsecond M'ler, rider of bronze Warith. (2857.11.02 – 2859.02.13) M'ler transferred to the Weyr after the Poisoning, and has been serving as a Wingleader since. He has a reputation for being a quiet, reliable man with passion for history.

Weyrleader L'ars, rider of bronze Phanth (2859.02.13 – present) A native of Ista Weyr and the son and grandson of Weyrleaders, L'ars was a popular choice as Weyrleader after young G'tin's tenure. L'ars promised an immediate return to tradition, stripping away A'nar's experiments with the position so that once again, the Weyrleader of Kadanzer commanded both his own Wing and the entire Weyr. He also demoted G'tin from Wingleader of SkyTamer back to wingrider, and shuffled wingsecond positions throughout the combat Wings, promoting young bronzeriders and demoting more experienced brownriders where necessary, in an effort to ensure that more of the Weyr's future Weyrleader pool had direct leadership experience. L'ars's leadership style is more informal than the Weyr has experienced since B'deras served as Weyrleader four Turns previous.

- Weyrsecond R'mal, rider of bronze Udoth. (2859.02.14 – present) R'mal's logistical genius and smooth diplomatic skills are again being put to use in a third tour of duty as Weyrsecond, this time under L'ars.



THE FLIGHTS:

Each Flight is composed of three Wings, and is led by a Flightleader who has command of those Wings during Threadfall. For each Wing, wingseconds are listed with each wingleader under whom they served.

WINDFLIGHT FLIGHTLEADER:

- K'rel, rider of bronze Asheth (2850.09.15-2853.01.01); K'rel served as Flightleader after the Poisoning until his death on 2853.01.01.
- R'mal, rider of bronze Udoth (2853.01.01 – present); R'mal served as Flightleader after K'rel's death, and has held the position ever since.

SKYFLIGHT FLIGHTLEADERS:

- G'vet, rider of bronze Vuerth (2850.09.15 –2853.04.15); G'vet was the first Flightleader for SkyFlight after the Poisoning. He suffered a heart attack on 2853.04.15 and as a result, retired back to Eastern Weyr. G'vet was known for his competent leadership in the skies, but on the ground, he had a William Shatner-esque presence that some weyrfolk found aggravating.
- Kr'is, rider of bronze Peprath (2853.04.15 – 2854.10.23); an ambitious bronzerider from Ista, Kr'is served as Flightleader of SkyFlight until his decision to transfer back to Ista Weyr, with an eye on the senior queen's next Mating Flight. He won the Weyrleadership of that Weyr, but died in Threadfall after less than a Turn in that position.
- K'din, rider of bronze Dormiath (2853.07.15 – 2855.01.10). Like K'rel before him, K'din acted as both Flightleader and Weyrleader during his time in power.
- B'deras, rider of bronze Rath (2855.01.10 – present). B'deras has served as Flightleader of SkyFlight since early 2855.

STARFLIGHT FLIGHTLEADERS:

- J'ret, rider of bronze Relareth (2850.09.15 – 2853.01.01). J'ret was a native of High Reaches Weyr and first served as a Wingleader and Flightleader at Kadanzer Weyr. Having lost his dragon in the same tragic accident which killed K'rel and Lauria on 2853.0.01, he himself died approximately one sevenday later.
- Th'rin, rider of bronze Wardreth (2853.01.01 – 2857.02.10) Originally from Telgar, Th'rin transferred to Kadanzer after the Poisoning, where he served as a wingleader, Flightleader and Weyrleader. He was badly injured in the Threadfall which forced the dissolution of the StarFlight Wings, and was forced to recuperate for several months; when he returned to the Wings, he was made wingleader of FireBlaze Wing.

FIREFLIGHT FLIGHTLEADERS:

- L'ars, rider of bronze Phanth (2854.02.01 – present). A native of Ista Weyr, L'ars was recruited by Weyrleader K'din when FireFlight was created. He has served as Flightleader of FireFlight since then.



FLAMEWIND WING

Wingleader J'riel, bronze Brinnoth (pre-Pass to 2850.09.13). A hearty, jovial man with a taste for harvest ales and dragonpoker, J'riel served as Wingleader of FlameWind Wing for over two decades, and served as Weyrsecond for nearly one decade. He died in the Poisoning.

- Wingsecond K'remi, rider of brown Kleorth (pre-Pass to 2845.07.15). The father of Demiri, J'mini and L'remi (deceased); survived the loss of his brown and currently lives at Fairview Cothold in Cibola territory.
- Wingsecond D'zan, rider of brown Yoseth (2845.07.15 – 2850.09.15). D'zan replaced his mentor, brownrider K'remi, as wingsecond in FlameWind Wing. He served in that position until the Poisoning.

- Wingsecond L'ward, rider of blue Danforth (2845.10.01 to 2850.10); L'ward retired from the combat Wings after sustaining the Threadscore that cost him an eye; the injury happened within the first days of the Pass, and served as a reminder to the Weyrleader that blues weren't meant for performing as wingseconds, despite the skills of the rider.

R'mal, rider of bronze Udoth (2850.09.16 – present) The younger brother of Lord Janol of Sunstone Hold, R'mal was Searched by Landing Weyr while a fosterling in Landing's territory. He transferred to Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. In 2852.09.24, R'mal briefly transferred to Eastern to be with his lover, bronzerider K'havlier. When K'havlier died shortly thereafter, R'mal returned to take up the leadership of FlameWind again on 2852.10.13; a replacement had not yet been decided during his absence.

- Wingsecond T'ryne, rider of brown Perinath (2850.10.01 – 2859.02.15); T'ryne transferred to Kadanzer from High Reaches Weyr after the Poisoning and served as senior wingsecond in FlameWind for nearly nine Turns, before being transferred to the Weyrling Wing on 2859.02.15 in favor of bronzerider S'tel in Weyrleader's L'ars's wingsecond restructuring effort.
- Wingsecond N'varre, rider of brown Goliath. (2852.03.01 – 2853.10.13) N'varre transferred to Kadanzer from Fort Weyr; he was later injured on 2853.10.13 in a hunting accident and transferred to Thornblaze Hold as watchrider; returned to the Wing as a wingrider in 2854.01. Later, he transferred to Ista Weyr for medical reasons.
- Wingsecond K'bort, rider of brown Jarvath (2853.10.14 – 2855.03.08). K'bort transferred to Kadanzer, and into FlameWind, from Eastern Weyr after the Poisoning. He lost his arm to Threadscore on 2855.03.08, and was later transferred to the Weyrling Wing.
- Wingsecond K'yrel, rider of bronze Terianth (2855.03.09 – present). K'yrel transferred to Kadanzer Weyr from the High Reaches in a political exchange, and took over the wingsecond position after K'bort was crippled. He became senior wingsecond in 2859.02.15
- Wingsecond S'tel, rider of bronze Valorith (2859.02.15 – present). A Kadanzer Hold native before he was Searched, S'tel was promoted to wingsecond 2859.02.15 in Weyrleader's L'ars's wingsecond restructuring effort; L'ars insisted on S'tel's promotion, as L'ars questioned Wingsecond K'yrel's leadership abilities.

STORMWIND WING

Wingleader K'rel, rider of bronze Asheth (2850.09.15 – 2853.01.01); transferred in from Telgar Weyr; won the Weyrleadership a little more than a sevenday later. Died on 2853.01.01 in a freak accident – when traveling to Telgar Weyr with his sister Lauria and good friend J'ret, none of them thought to check ahead for the weather. They arrived in the middle of a terrible blizzard, and collided with the mountains; the mountains won.

- Wingsecond D'zan, rider of brown Yoseth (2850.09.16– 2853.13.18); *see previous biographical information.*
- Wingsecond D'glis, rider of brown Nuarth (2850.09.16 – 2852.02.28); a native of Kadanzer Weyr, D'glis served as wingsecond of StormWind from 2850.09.16 to 2852.02.28, when he transferred on to SkyTamer Wing.
- Wingsecond M'kel, rider of brown Jenith (2852.03.01 -- 2855.01.01) A Kadanzer native who transferred to Ista before the start of the Pass, M'kel returned to Kadanzer after the Poisoning. He flew first in SkyTamer Wing before becoming Weyrleader K'rel's junior wingsecond in StormWind in early 2852. In 2855.01.01, he returned to Ista Weyr to serve under its new Weyrleader, his old friend Kr'is.

Wingleader B'nalsh, rider of bronze Drannath (2853.01.02 – 2856.04.16) Raised at the healer's hall at Ista Hold and Searched by Ista Weyr, B'nalsh transferred to Kadanzer in late 2852, after the death of a woman he loved. Upon K'rel's death, he was named wingleader of StormWind, despite having been with Kadanzer for only a few sevendays. After the destruction of the caldera of the Old Weyr on 2856.04.15, B'nalsh was transferred to FireStar, to rebuild that devastated Wing after its near-total destruction.

- Wingsecond M'kel, rider of brown Jenith (2852.03.01 -- 2855.01.01); *see biographical information above.*
- Wingsecond B'kuto, rider of brown Ilerith (2853.13.20 – 2857.13.28) A native of Eastern Weyr, B'kuto transferred to the Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. Before replacing D'zan as wingsecond in StormWind, B'kuto served with StarToucher and SkySoaring Wings. He transferred on to SkyTamer on 2857.13.28.
- Wingsecond B'raniz, rider of bronze Lygnoth (2855.01.01—2856.04.16) A Kadanzer Weyr native who Impressed after the Poisoning, B'raniz served as wingsecond in StormWind for a Turn and a half before getting his shot at being a wingleader.

Wingleader B'raniz, rider of bronze Lygnoth (2856.04.16 – 2857.11.03); B'raniz inherited the wingleadership of StormWind from B'nalsh; when G'tin won the Weyrleadership in 2857.11, the new Weyrleader judged B'raniz the youngest and most inexperienced of the wingleaders, and demoted him back to wingsecond status, transferring command of StormWind to bronzerider A'nar.

- Wingsecond B'kuto, rider of brown Ilerith (2853.13.20 – 2857.13.21) *see biographical information above.*
- Wingsecond R'nen, rider of brown Imeth (2856.04.16 – 2859.02.15) A native of Thornblaze Hold who impressed his brown before the Poisoning, R'nen flew with SkyMaster before transferring to StormWind in mid-2854.

Wingleader A'nar, rider of bronze Garath (2857.11.03 – present). When young G'tin's Fordath won Nicareth's first Weyrleadership Flight, G'tin reassigned A'nar to StormWind Wing, displacing B'raniz back to a wingsecond position in FireStar, under B'nalsh.

- Wingsecond R'nen (2856.04.16 – present) *See biographical information above.*
- Wingsecond V'kam, rider of bronze Selputh (2857.10 – 2857.13.21). A native of Eastern Weyr, V'kam transferred to Kadanzer Weyr in 2857.10, after some conflict with a wingleader back at Eastern. He inherited the wingsecondship from B'kuto.

STRONGWIND WING

Wingleader H'rem, rider of bronze Tyquerth (2850.09.16 – 2852.06.28); a native of Eastern Weyr, H'rem was mortally wounded in Threadfall on 2852.06.28.

- Wingsecond Jallori, rider of brown Nusrath (2850.09.16 – 2857.06.24) A native of High Reaches Weyr, Jallori refused to serve under Wingleader Z'hon whom she had known from there, and was transferred to the Queen's Wing as punishment.
- Wingsecond Jh'rver, rider of bronze Gomlryeth (2850.09.16 – 2852.06.28). Jh'rver transferred back to Igen Weyr after H'rem's death.
- Wingsecond A'lerin, rider of brown Tiralith (2852.07.01 – 2853.06.13) A native of Maori Hold, A'lerin succeeded Jh'rver as a wingsecond in StrongWind. He left StrongWind for a short career in SkySoaring Wing.

Wingleader A'dan, rider of bronze Iykath (2852.07.01 – 2853.07.21) A'dan transferred to Kadanzer from Igen Weyr a few months after the Poisoning, along with his siblings A'lynd, A'drian, and Andriana. He served as wingsecond to J'ret of SkyToucher prior to his promotion as wingleader with StrongWind. When K'din became Weyrleader, he and his siblings transferred back to Igen.

- Wingsecond Jallori, rider of brown Nusrath (2850.09.16 – 2857.06.24) *see biographical information above*
- Wingsecond G'nan, rider of bronze Takarth (2852.06.13 – 2854.05.15) one of only two bronzeriders to have survived the Kadanzer Poisoning, G'nan served his entire career as a combat rider in StrongWind Wing, eventually working his way up through the ranks to wingleader. His bronze Takarth suffered a crippling Threadscore that required the amputation of a wing, and the dragonpair were transferred to the Weyrling Wing.
- Wingsecond V'lar, rider of bronze Jreth (2854.05.15 – 2856.10.24). A native of Thornblaze Hold, this bronzerider Impressed at Kadanzer shortly after the Poisoning. After the Poisoning. V'lar was appointed as wingsecond of SkySoaring Wing under B'deras, but lasted less than a day. He was transferred to StrongWind as wingsecond on 2854.05.15. On 2856.10.24, he was transferred to StarRacer after the death of StarRacer's wingsecond T'dzio.

Wingleader J'van, rider of bronze Tregarth (2853.07.21 – 2854.05.15) A native of Ista, J'van inherited the wingleadership of StrongWind from A'dan, and passed it on to G'nan, returning back to Ista after an argument with Weyrleader K'din.

- Wingsecond Jallori, rider of brown Nusrath (2850.09.16 – 2857.06.24) *see Jallori's biographical information above*
- Wingsecond G'nan, rider of bronze Takarth (2852.06.13 – 2854.05.15) *see G'nan's biographical informational above*

Wingleader G'nan, rider of bronze Takarth (2854.05.15 – 2857.06.18) G'nan was only one of two bronzeriders to have survived the Kadanzer Poisoning. He served much of his career as a combat rider in StrongWind Wing,

working his way up through the ranks to wingleader. His bronze Takarth suffered a crippling Threadscore that required the amputation of a wing, and the dragonpair were transferred to duty in the Weyrling Wing.

- Wingsecond Jallori, rider of brown Nusrath (2850.09.16 – 2857.06.24) *see Jallori's biographical information above*
- Wingsecond Q'wen, rider of brown Tendith (2856.10.24 -- present) a former sailor, Q'wen inherited V'Iar's wingsecond position.

Wingleader Z'hon, rider of bronze Ulairith (2857.06.24 – present) A native of the High Reaches Weyr, Z'hon came to Kadanzer when promised StrongWind after G'nan's bronze was crippled.

- Wingsecond Q'wen, rider of brown Tendith (2856.10.24 – 2858.13.25) *see Q'wen's biographical information above*. Q'wen was demoted in favor of M'qua in late 2858 for unclear reasons (in truth, it was because Z'hon discovered Q'wen's secret hobby of lace making).
- Wingsecond O'ris, rider of brown Jetoth (2857.06.24 – 2859.02.15). A native of Izmir Hold, O'ris inherited the wingsecond position from Jallori. He was demoted in 2859.02.15 in favor of bronzerider T'noh in Weyrleader's L'ars's wingsecond restructuring effort; O'ris chose to remain with his Wing rather than transfer to the Weyrling Wing as a weyrlingassistant.
- Wingsecond M'qua, rider of brown Ursuth (2858.13.25 – present); M'qua Impressed at Kadanzer, and has served in StrongWind since his graduation from the Weyrling Wing in 2852; inherited Q'wen's position as wingsecond.
- Wingsecond T'noh, rider of bronze Renath (2859.02.15 – present). A native of a Maori cothold, T'noh is a reckless young man who walks with a slight limp due to a childhood injury. Promoted as part of Weyrleader L'ars's wingsecond reshuffling efforts on 2859.02.15.



SKYMASTER WING

Wingleader G'vet, rider of bronze Vuerth (2850.09.16 – 2853.04.15); Having transferred in to Kadanzer immediately after the Poisoning, G'vet later suffered a heart attack and retired to Eastern Weyr. He was known for his competent leadership in the skies, but on the ground, he had a William Shatner-esque presence that some weyrfolk found aggravating.

- Wingsecond D'zan, rider of brown Yoseth (2850.09.16 – 2850.09.26) after only ten days' service, D'zan was demoted from SkyMaster and transferred to StormWind for disrespectful language directed at Wingleader G'vet.
- Wingsecond R'kil, rider of brown Adobiath (2850.09.16 – 2853.07.16); an older rider, R'kil chose to retire from the combat Wings and follow G'vet back to Eastern
- Wingsecond E'vel, rider of brown Laeth (2850.09.26 – 2857.02.10) A brownrider from Telgar, E'vel was a quiet, methodical and unassuming man. Died in Threadfall on 2857.02.10, in the terrible 'Fall which forced the dissolution of StarFlight.

Wingleader K'din, rider of bronze Dormiath (2853.04.15 – 2855.01.10) K'din was a childhood sweetheart of Weyrwoman Tanara's; they were lovers for a time, before her dedication to the dragonhealer craft came between them. After G'vet was disabled by a heart attack, Weyrleader D'zan recruited K'din to the Kadanzer Weyr as SkyMaster's new wingleader (this action was galvanized in part by D'zan's disgust at hearing bronzeriders Kr'is, J'van, J'fer, and others plotting on how to win Renorath's upcoming mating flight). K'din served as Weyrleader for two tours of duty before transferring himself back to the High Reaches.

- Wingsecond E'vel, rider of brown Laeth (2850.09.26 – 2857.02.10) *see E'vel's biographical information above*.
- Wingsecond D'lin, rider of bronze Heveth (2854.07.16 -- 2854.13.28); D'lin came to Kadanzer from Ista Weyr after a venomous disagreement with then-Weyrleader R'sarn; he transferred back to Ista Weyr in 2854.13 for medical reasons. The father of Valenne's daughter Verinne, D'lin served both as K'din's wingsecond and weyrsecond for most of K'din's time at the Weyr.
- Wingsecond S'kash, rider of bronze Girmanth (2854.13.28 – 2855.01.10) One of only two bronzeriders to survive the Poisoning, S'kash served as K'din's wingsecond for only nine days before being named wingleader of SkyMaster.

Wingleader S'kash, rider of bronze Girmanth (2855.01.10 – 2857.02.10) A native of Cibola territory, S'kash served as wingsecond in SkySoaring before a brief tour of duty as Weyrleader K'din's wingsecond; one of K'din's last actions before leaving the Weyrleadership of Kadanzer was to make young S'kash wingleader of SkyMaster in his stead. It was an action that was doubted by many at the time, but S'kash proved himself capable and competent. He was badly injured in the devastating Threadfall of 2857.02.10; after recuperating for several months from his injuries, he returned to active duty as a wingsecond for M'ler.

- Wingsecond E'vel, rider of brown Laeth (2850.09.26 – 2857.02.10) A brownrider from Telgar, E'vel was a quiet, methodical and unassuming man. Died in Threadfall on 2857.02.10, in the terrible 'Fall which forced the dissolution of StarFlight.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2855.01.10 – 2857.02.10)*

Wingleader M'ler, rider of bronze Warith (2857.02.10 -- present) A Fort Weyr native, M'ler rebuilt StarToucher Wing after the Poisoning. When StarFlight was disbanded after being devastated by a terrible Threadfall in 2857.02, M'ler was transferred to SkyMaster as wingleader.

- Wingsecond V'lar, rider of bronze Jreth (2857.02.10 – present). A native of Thornblaze Hold, V'lar impressed shortly after the Poisoning. He served as a wingsecond in StrongWind and StarRacer before being transferred to SkyMaster after the dissolution of StarFlight.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2859.02.15) [Note: this position is being held in reserve for future bronzerider characters of an appropriate age to be backdated into the club's history.]*

SKYSOARING WING

Wingleader B'deras, rider of bronze Rath (2852.04.15 – present). B'deras transferred from Ista Weyr on 2852.04.15, along with his mother (Headsecond Bella) and sister (Craftmaster Giselle). All three saw unparalleled opportunities for advancement at the Weyr. B'deras has a reputation for going through wingseconds like Rath consumes kittens, although his senior wingsecond, D'camron, has somehow remained in his post throughout the Turns. (How does he manage it? The rest of the Weyr's wingseconds want to know!) Not all of B'deras's wingseconds are detailed here, giving new members possible room to backdate their personas. Likewise, not all biographical information is provided for the named wingseconds. You can find that information elsewhere in this article.

- Wingsecond D'camron, rider of brown Anoreth (2850.09.16 -- present) transferred to Kadanzer after the Poisoning from Telgar; was promoted by B'deras as his wingsecond from within the SkySoaring ranks, and has withstood the test of time.
- Wingsecond K'torek, rider of brown Orkanth (2850.10.01 – 2851.05.09)
- *Wingsecond unknown (2851.05.09 – 2852.04.15)*
- Wingsecond J'nec, rider of brown Hunith (2852.04.15 – 2852.06.14)
- *Wingsecond unknown (2852.06.14 – 2853.02.08)*
- Wingsecond D'lin, rider of bronze Heveth (2853.02.10– 2853.04.16) D'lin's career in SkySoaring Wing was cut short after he called B'deras a "Mama's Boy".
- Wingsecond B'kuto, rider of brown Ilerith (2853.04.16 – 2853.06.12)
- Wingsecond A'lerin, rider of brown Tiralith (2853.06.13 – 2853.07.23)
- Wingsecond L'rec, rider of brown Jinnixth (2853.07.24 – 2854.01.28)
- Wingsecond S'kash, rider of bronze Girmanth (2854.01.28 -- 2855.01.09)
- Wingsecond V'lar, rider of bronze Jreth (2855.01.09 – 2855.01.09) V'lar holds the distinction of being B'deras's wingsecond with the fastest turnaround – less than eight hours. The paperwork cites poorly polished boots; the greenriders in SkySoaring still contend that it was V'lar's gorgeous red hair...
- *Wingsecond unknown*
- *Wingsecond unknown*
- Wingsecond Jallori, rider of brown Nusrath (2857.11.09 – 2857.11.10) Jallori lasted little more than a day with SkySoaring Wing, as her brown Nusrath was partially blinded by Thread during their first 'Fall with the Wing.
- *Wingsecond unknown*
- *Wingsecond unknown*
- Wingsecond F'ico, rider of bronze Uleth (2859.02.15 – present). A journeyman weaver prior to his having been Searched, F'ico was transferred into SkySoaring as part of Weyrleader L'ars's wingsecond restructuring effort.

SKYTAMER WING

Wingleader Kr'is, rider of bronze Peprath (2850.10.01 – 2854.12.15). Like so many others, Kr'is transferred to Kadanzer from Ista Weyr after the Poisoning; after K'din won his second Kadanzer Weyrleadership, Kr'is transferred back to Ista in 2854.12, and within a month had won the Istan Weyrleadership. Deceased in 2855, killed in Threadfall.

- Wingsecond H'ro, rider of bronze Ganth (2850.10.01 – 2854.12.16) The younger brother of bronzerider D'lin, H'ro transferred to Kadanzer after the Poisoning along with his Wingleader, Kr'is.
- Wingsecond M'kel, rider of brown Jenith (2850.09.18 – 2852.02.28). A Kadanzer native who transferred to Ista before the start of the Pass, M'kel returned to Kadanzer after the Poisoning. He served first in SkyTamer Wing before becoming Weyrleader K'rel's junior wingsecond in early 2852. In 2855.01.01, he returned to Ista Weyr to serve under Weyrleader Kr'is.
- Wingsecond D'glis, rider of brown Nuarth (2852.03.01 – present). A native of Kadanzer Weyr, D'glis served as wingsecond of StormWind from 2850.09.16 to 2852.02.28, before transferring on to SkyTamer Wing. Has served as senior wingsecond in SkyTamer Wing since.

Wingleader H'ro, rider of bronze Ganth (2854.12.16 -- 2854.10.23) Wingleader H'ro was lost during Threadfall. *See biographical information above.*

- Wingsecond D'glis, rider of brown Nuarth (2852.03.01 – present) *See biographical information above.*
- L'rian, rider of bronze Goryneth (2853.02.02 – 2854.10.24) *See biographical information below.*

Wingleader L'rian, rider of bronze Goryneth (2854.10.24 – 2858.11.10) A native of High Reaches, L'rian transferred to Kadanzer and SkyTamer in 2853.02, in search of his biological father, Weyrharper Andrian. He inherited SkyTamer upon H'ro's death, and later died in Threadfall himself on 2858.11.10.

- Wingsecond D'glis, rider of brown Nuarth (2852.03.01 – present) *See biographical information above.*
- *Wingsecond unknown* (2854.10.24 – 2857.13.28)
- Wingsecond B'kuto, rider of brown Ilerith (2858.01.01 – present) A native of Eastern Weyr, B'kuto transferred to the Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. B'kuto has served as a wingsecond in SkyTamer, StormWind, StarToucher, and SkySoaring Wings before his transfer to SkyTamer.

Wingleader G'tin, rider of bronze Fordath (2858.11.10 – 2859.02.14) Young Weyrleader G'tin's choice to name himself as Wingleader of SkyTamer after L'rian's death in Threadfall was not popular among the other bronzeriders, both due to G'tin's age and lack of experience, and due to the fact that other older and more qualified bronzeriders with previous wingleader experience were available at the time.

- Wingsecond D'glis, rider of brown Nuarth (2852.03.01 – present) *See biographical information above.*
- Wingsecond B'kuto, rider of brown Ilerith (2858.01.01 – 2859.02.15) A native of Eastern Weyr, B'kuto transferred to the Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. B'kuto has served as a wingsecond in SkyTamer, StormWind, StarToucher, and SkySoaring Wings.

Wingleader T'jalden, rider of bronze Lamoroth (2859.02.14 – present) A native of Igen Hold, T'jalden came to the Weyr after the Poisoning. He served as wingsecond in SkySoaring and StarRacer before serving as wingleader of StarRacer after A'nar won the Weyrleadership in late 2856. He was badly injured in the devastating Threadfall of 2857.02 which resulted in the dissolution of StarFlight; when recovered, he was transferred to a wingsecond position in FireBlaze Wing, where he served until promoted Wingleader of SkyTamer by Weyrleader L'ars.

- Wingsecond D'glis, rider of brown Nuarth (2852.03.01 – present) *See biographical information above.*
- Wingsecond S'kash, rider of bronze Girmanth (2859.02.15 -- present). A native of Cibola territory and one of only two bronzeriders to survive the 2850 Poisoning, S'kash served as wingsecond in SkySoaring before a brief tour of duty as Weyrleader K'din's wingsecond; one of K'din's last actions before leaving the Weyrleadership of Kadanzer was to make young S'kash wingleader of SkyMaster in his stead. It was an action that was doubted by many at the time, but S'kash proved himself capable and competent. He was badly injured in the devastating Threadfall of 2857.02.10; after recuperating for several months from his injuries, he returned to active duty as a wingsecond for M'ler, and served in SkyMaster until 2859.02.15, when he was transferred to SkyTamer to serve as T'jalden's wingsecond.



STARRACER WING

Wingleader I'vay, rider of bronze Piroeth (2850.10.01 – 2853.03.12): I'vay transferred from Landing Weyr to Kadanzer after the Poisoning; he was once described by D'zan as being “a good man, if more sour than a tomcat with the leaks.” He was killed in Threadfall.

- Wingsecond L'remi, rider of bronze Orionith (2850.10.01 – 2853.03.12) A native of Kadanzer Weyr, L'remi had a violent falling-out with his father, Wingsecond K'remi of FlameWind; he wound up at Landing Weyr as a weyrherder apprentice, where he was Searched and Impressed, pre-Pass.
- Wingsecond B'tai, rider of brown Chobith (2850.10.01– 2854.01.28) A native of Eastern Weyr, B'tai is a fun-loving rogue who is strong in verbal leadership, but doesn't particularly appreciate hard work. When A'nar took leadership of StarRacer, B'tai led a faction of disgruntled riders away to the newly founded FireStorm Wing. He was a major influence in making FireStorm what it is (or isn't, in some minds) today.

Wingleader L'remi, rider of bronze Orionith (2853.03.12 – 2853.10.15) A native of Kadanzer who impressed at Landing Weyr, L'remi was mortally wounded in a hunting accident. During L'remi's tenure as wingleader, StarRacer had a reputation as a merrymaker's Wing.

- Wingsecond B'tai, rider of brown Chobith (2850.10.01– 2854.01.28) *See biographical information above*
- *Wingsecond unknown (2853.03.12 – 2857.02.10)*

Wingleader A'nar, rider of bronze Garath (2853.10.15 – 2856.13.26) At the news of L'remi's death, A'nar hung up his Weyrleader's knots and requested a transfer back to the combat Wings. Prior to A'nar's arrival, StarRacer had a reputation as a fun-loving, mellow group of riders, and many riders transferred away from A'nar's more driven, serious approach as wingleader. When A'nar won the Weyrleadership, he resigned his position as wingleader, nominating T'jalden in his stead.

- *Wingsecond unknown (2853.03.12 – 2857.02.10)*
- Wingsecond T'dzio, rider of brown Sartenth (2853.10.15 – 2856.10.23) After serving with A'nar for most of his life, T'dzio took himself and his dragon *between* when diagnosed with terminal cancer.
- Wingsecond V'lar, rider of bronze Jreth (2856.10.24 – 2857.02.10) A native of Thornblaze Hold, V'lar impressed shortly after the Poisoning. He transferred into StarRacer Wing from StrongWind as a replacement for Wingsecond T'dzio.

Wingleader T'jalden, rider of bronze Lamoroth (2856.13.27 – 2857.02.10) A native of Igen Hold, T'jalden came to the Weyr after the Poisoning. Served as wingsecond in SkySoaring and StarRacer before serving as wingleader of StarRacer after A'nar won the Weyrleadership in late 2856. He was badly injured in the devastating Threadfall of 2857.02 which resulted in the dissolution of StarFlight; when recovered, he was transferred to a wingsecond position in FireBlaze Wing.

- Wingsecond V'lar, rider of bronze Jreth (2856.10.24 – 2857.02.10) A native of Thornblaze Hold, V'lar impressed shortly after the Poisoning. He transferred into StarRacer Wing from StrongWind as a replacement for Wingsecond T'dzio.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2856.13.27 – 2857.02.10)*

STARSINGER WING

Wingleader M'ler, rider of bronze Warith (2850.09.18 – 2857.02.10). A quiet, commanding presence, M'ler is a Fort Weyr native who came to the Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. He led StarSinger from his arrival until a devastating Threadfall on 2857.02.10, after which Weyrleader A'nar disbanded all of StarFlight, transferring all of the surviving StarFlight riders into the Weyr's other three Flights.

- Wingsecond T'jalden, rider of bronze Lamoroth (2850.10.01 -- 2852.08.28) Despite having served as M'ler's wingsecond for Turns, T'jalden was demoted in 2852 for inappropriate behavior (using his rank to earn sexual favors among his own wingriders).
- Wingsecond K'torek, rider of brown Orkanth (2852.08.28 – 2855.02.21); a native of Fort Weyr, K'torek transferred to Kadanzer after the Poisoning with Wingleader M'ler, but served some time with SkySoaring before returning to StarSinger as wingsecond. Was demoted for using his rank to claim sexual favors; was flying with FireStar on the day of the eruption of Mt. Kadanzer.

- Wingsecond D'rule, rider of bronze Zaireth (2852.09.01 -- 2854.01.01). Tried to go *between* while drunk; came out of *between* embedded in a ridgeline in Drake Hold territory.
- Wingsecond T'jalden, rider of bronze Lamoroth (2854.01.01 -- 2857.02.10) Although he had been demoted two Turns earlier for inappropriate behavior (see above), he was again given a wingsecond position, replacing the ill-fated D'rule and serving in this position until he and Lamoroth were both injured in the event that forced the dissolution of StarFlight.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2855.02.21 – 2857.02.10)*

STARTOUCHER WING

Wingleader J'ret, rider of bronze Relarenth (2850.10.01 – 2853.01.01). Transferred to Kadanzer from the High Reaches; he died on 2853.01.01 in a freak accident while traveling to Telgar Weyr with friends Lauria and K'rel. Strangely, none of them thought to check with Telgar for the weather before *betweening*. They arrived in the middle of a terrible blizzard, and collided with the mountains of their birthplace. J'ret alone survived the accident itself, his dragon's death, and a night left exposed on the mountain in freezing temperatures. He died approximately a sevenday later, without having regained consciousness.

- Wingsecond J'vel, rider of bronze Nyeth (2850.09.20 -- 2857.02.10) A bronzerider from Ista, J'vel was too given to impetuous stunts to ever be trusted with a wingleadership. Died in the devastating Threadfall that led to the dissolution of the StarFlight Wings.
- Wingsecond A'dan, rider of bronze Roth (2851.01.20 – 2852.06.28) A'dan transferred to Kadanzer from Igen Weyr a few months after the Poisoning, along with his siblings A'lynd, A'drian, and Andriana. He served as wingsecond in SkyToucher Wing prior to his promotion as wingleader with StrongWind. When K'din became Weyrleader, he and his siblings transferred back to Igen.

Wingleader Th'rin, rider of bronze Wardreth (2853.01.01 – 2857.02.10) Originally from Telgar, Th'rin transferred to Kadanzer after the Poisoning, where he served as a wingleader and Weyrleader. He was badly injured in the Threadfall which forced the dissolution of the StarFlight Wings, and was forced to recuperate for several months.

- Wingsecond J'vel, rider of bronze Nyeth (2850.09.20 -- 2857.02.10) *See J'vel's biographical information above.*
- Wingsecond A'drian, rider of bronze Roth (2851.02.14 – 2853.07.21) a native of Igen Weyr, A'drian and his siblings transferred to the Weyr after the Poisoning. A'drian was an intelligent, trusting young man. Returned to Igen with the rest of his siblings in 2853.07.
- Wingsecond B'kuto, rider of brown Ilerith (2852.07.02 – 2853.04.16). A native of Eastern Weyr, B'kuto transferred to the Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. He replaced D'zan as wingsecond in StormWind, B'kuto before going on to serve as wingsecond in StarToucher, SkySoaring and SkyTamer Wings. He transferred on the Weyrling Wing as a weyrlingassistant in early 2859.02.



FIREBLAZE WING

Wingleader R'ket, rider of bronze Mondeth (2854.02.01 – 2857.07.07) An intelligent man who transferred to Kadanzer from Fort Weyr in 2851, R'ket was a stereotypical bronzerider -- handsome, cultured, and capable of pure arrogance. Killed in Threadfall.

- Wingsecond A'lerin, rider of brown Tiralith (2854.02.01 – present) A native of Maori Hold, A'lerin served as a wingsecond in StrongWind and SkySoaring before transferring to FireBlaze.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2854.02.01 – 2857.08.07)*

Wingleader Th'rin, rider of bronze Wardreth (2857.07.07 -- present) Originally from Telgar, Th'rin transferred to Kadanzer after the Poisoning, where he served as a wingleader. Won the Weyrleadership from B'deras in 2856, and was Weyrleader during the chaos of the Weyr's relocation to its new site. He returned to the combat Wings in 2857, and took over the leadership of FireBlaze Wing after R'ket's death.

- Wingsecond A'lerin, rider of brown Tiralith (2854.02.01 – present) Please see A'lerin's biographical information above.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2854.02.01 – 2857.08.07)*

- Wingsecond T'jalden, rider of bronze Lamoroth (2857.08.07 – 2859.02.14) A native of Igen Hold, T'jalden came to the Weyr after the Poisoning. He served as a wingsecond in both SkySoaring and StarSinger, and later as a wingleader for StarRacer. He was badly burned in the devastating Threadfall of 2857.02.10 which resulted in the dissolution of StarFlight; when he had recovered from his injuries, he was transferred into FireBlaze as a wingsecond. On 2859.02.14, Weyrleader L'ars promoted T'jalden to Wingleader of SkyTamer Wing, replacing G'tin in that position.
- Wingsecond V'rili, rider of bronze Koranth (2859.02.15 – present). A native of Thornblaze Hold, V'rili was a hold guard, married, and father of two children when he was Searched. Inherited his wingsecond position as part of Weyrleader L'ars's wingsecond restructuring effort.

FIRESTAR WING

Wingleader J'fer, rider of bronze Sermath (2854.02.01—2856.04.06) A native of Ista Weyr, J'fer had a passion for knife-throwing. He was killed in an earthquake at the old Weyr at Kadanzer Mountain.

- Wingsecond D'nair, rider of brown Bevorith (2854.02.01 – 2856.04.15) A cheerful, fun-loving man, D'nair was a long-time friend of Weyrwoman Tanara's and a survivor of the Poisoning. Deceased in the explosion of Kadanzer Mountain.
- Wingsecond H'lsey, rider of brown Atanth (2854.02.01 – 2856.04.15) A quiet, methodical man, H'lsey was a survivor of the Kadanzer Poisoning. Killed in the eruption of Kadanzer Mountain.

Wingleader B'nalsh, rider of bronze Drannath (2856.04.16 – present) Raised at the healer's hall at Ista Hold and Searched by Ista Weyr, B'nalsh transferred to Kadanzer in early 2852, after the death of a woman he loved. He took up the wingleadership of StormWind upon K'rel's death. After final eruption of Kadanzer mountain on 2856.04.15 killed virtually all of FireStar's riders, B'nalsh was transferred in to build the replacement riders into a team.

- Wingsecond F'lco, rider of bronze Uleth (2856.04.16 – 2858.07.01). A journeyman weaver prior to his having been Searched, F'lco served with FireStar since B'nalsh took over the reins with this Wing. Sidelined by Threadfall injury in early 2858.07.01; after his recovery, he transferred to serve as a wingsecond in SkySoaring on 2859.02.15.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2856.04.16 – 2857.11.03)*
- Wingsecond B'raniz, rider of bronze Lygnoth (2857.11.03 – present); B'raniz inherited the wingleadership of StormWind from B'nalsh; when G'tin won the Weyrleadership in 2857.11, the new Weyrleader judged B'raniz the most inexperienced of the wingleaders, and demoted him back to wingsecond status, transferring command of StormWind to bronzerider A'nar and B'raniz on to FireStar.
- *Wingsecond unknown (2859.02.15) [Note: this position is being held in reserve for future bronzerider characters of an appropriate age to be backdated into the club's history.]*

FIRESTORM WING

Wingleader L'ars, rider of bronze Phanth (2854.02.01 – present) A native of Ista Weyr, L'ars was recruited by Weyrleader K'din as wingleader of FireStorm Wing when K'din founded FireFlight. He has served with FireStorm ever since.

- Wingsecond B'tai, rider of brown Chobith (2854.02.01– present) A native of Eastern Weyr, B'tai is a fun-loving rogue who is a major influence in making FireStorm what it is (or isn't, in some minds) today. Before coming to FireStorm, he served in StarRacer under L'remi. Soon after the more serious-minded A'nar took over as wingleader there, B'tai transferred into FireStorm and brought with him a cadre of merry pranksters who were also disgruntled with A'nar.
- Wingsecond L'rec, rider of brown Jinnixth (2854.02.01--2855.13.25) A native of Landing Weyr, L'rec was killed in Threadfall.
- Wingsecond K'danag, rider of brown Quilloth (2856.01 – 2859.02.15). Another native of Landing, and son of Weyrsmith Kild, K'danag flew for a time with StarToucher, before transferring into FireStorm as junior wingsecond. He was transferred to the Weyrwing Wing in 2859.02.15.
- Wingsecond Z'haq, rider of bronze Eowarth (2859.02.15 – present). A native of Rubicon Hold, cheerful and easy-going Z'haq has flown with FireStorm since his graduation from WC #10.



THE WEYRLING WING

A terminology note: up until D'zan took over the weyrlingmastership position, a "weyrlingsecond" was a title worn by a weyrlingmaster's senior assistant or chosen successor. When D'zan organized the Weyrling Wing, assigning individual instructors to each class of weyrlings, and shifting the title "weyrlingsecond" to a staff member who was responsible for a direct class. In turn, under D'zan's leadership, a "weyrlingassistant" is a Weyrling Wing staff member who isn't currently assigned to a class, and who is free to float as an assistant to any of the classes, and required by the instructors' daily needs.

Weyrlingmaster B'loren, rider of bronze Byrenth (2850.09.16 – 2852.13.27) A native of Fort Weyr, B'loren committed suicide after his bronze was killed in a training accident in the Weyr Bowl.

- Weyrlingsecond Casmir, rider of brown Vraith (2850.10.01 – 2852.13.28) Casmir resigned after B'loren's death, returning to the combat Wings. She now serves as a cross-crafted dragonhealer in the Queen's Wing. Casmir was killed in Threadfall in 2858.09.
- Weyrlingassistant L'ward, rider of blue Danforth (2850.09.16 – 2853.13.18). Blinded in one eye and badly scarred by Thread, L'ward has been a long-time presence in the Weyrling Wing. L'ward tried transferring back to service in the Queen's Wing on 2852.10.21, but was badly wounded shortly thereafter and returned to service in the Weyrling Wing by 2853.01.01.
- Weyrlingassistant A'nar, rider of bronze Garath (2851.10.01 – 2852.13.28) A'nar served for many years as Weyrlingmaster at Fort Weyr. Shortly before the Poisoning, he lost a weyrmate and an infant son; transferring to Kadanzer gave him a chance to get away from their deaths, although it also meant a drop in rank.
- Weyrlingassistant T'dzio, rider of brown Sartenth (2851.10.01 – 2852.13.28); T'dzio was dedicated to being A'nar's right-hand man, no matter the job. A devoted friend, he shadowed A'nar for many Turns.

Weyrlingmaster A'nar, rider of bronze Garath (2853.01.01 – 2853.10.15) A'nar returned to the combat Wings upon the death of StarRacer's Wingleader L'remi.

- Weyrlingsecond T'dzio, rider of brown Sartenth (2853.10.15 – 2856.10.23). *See T'dzio's biographical information above.*
- Weyrlingassistant L'ward, rider of blue Danforth (2850.09.16 – 2853.13.18) *See L'ward's biographical information above.*

Weyrlingmaster T'mon, rider of brown Quorth (2853.10.15 – 2853.13.18) killed in the massive Thornblaze Hold earthquake of 2853.13. He survived the initial earthquake itself, but was trapped in the hold ruins and died of his injuries before rescuers could reach him.

- Weyrlingassistant L'ward, rider of blue Danforth (2850.09.16 – 2853.13.18) *See L'ward's biographical information above.*
- Weyrlingassistant Shahara, rider of green Layketh (2853.10.21 – 2854.11.07). An Igen Weyr transferee, Shahara's no-nonsense approach made her a welcome addition to the Weyrling Wing.

Weyrlingmaster L'ward, rider of blue Danforth (2853.13.18 – 2854.10.09); L'ward took over the Weyrlingmastership upon T'mon's demise. Less than a Turn later, he was terribly injured in a weyrling live-flame accident, and neither he nor Danforth were expected to survive their injuries. Contrary to the healers' expectations, they both did, and L'ward returned as a weyrlingassistant under D'zan.

- Weyrlingsecond D'zan, rider of brown Yoseth (2854.01.01 – 2854.10.09). Having lost a leg during the Thornblaze earthquake, D'zan joined the Weyrling Wing at this time.
- Weyrlingassistant Shahara, rider of green Layketh (2853.10.21 – 2854.11.07). Shahara retired from the Weyrling Wing and flew for a short time with StormWind.

Weyrlingmaster D'zan, rider of brown Yoseth (2854.10.09 – present); D'zan became Weyrlingmaster after L'ward's incapacitating injuries; later, when L'ward had recovered, Weyrleaders B'deras and Tanara refused his request to step back to allow L'ward to return to the ranked position.

- Weyrlingassistant Shahara, rider of green Layketh (2855.01.07 – present) After serving for a short time in StormWind, Shahara returned to the Weyrling Wing. She has served as Weyrlingsecond for Weyrling Classes #10, #14 (one of the two rush-graduated after the eruption of Kadanzer Mountain), #20 and #27.

- Weyrlingassistant L'ward, rider of blue Danforth: (2855.01.07 – present) Proving yet again that he's made of stuff tougher than your average wherhide, L'ward and Danforth recovered from the burns which had been predicted would kill them, and returned to duty in the Weyrling Wing in early 2855. He served as weyrlingsecond of Classes #12, #18, & #21, and #26.
- Weyrlingassistant Kase, rider of green Tarsith (2855.01.01 – 2855.11.06); a native of Fort who transferred to Kadanzer along with Wingleader M'ler, Kase and her green were crippled by Threadscores in late 2854. Weyrlingsecond of WC #11. Kase and her green were later killed in a live-flame weyrling accident on 2855.11.06.
- Weyrlingassistant T'bias, rider of brown Caldeth. (2854.07.01 – 2856.01.25) A native of an Ista seahold, T'bias served as Weyrlingsecond for Weyrling Class #13, but upon their graduation was sent packing back to the combat wings by Weyrlingmaster D'zan, after proving unable to stop flirting with his students. Died in a Mating Flight accident with one of his graduates soon after.
- Weyrlingassistant B'baer, rider of blue Lynsoth (2855.02.01 – present) One of the most colorful blueriders in the Weyr, ex-seacrafter B'baer has served as Weyrlingsecond for Weyrling Classes #15 (one of the two classes rush-graduated immediately after the disastrous eruption of Kadanzer Mountain in 2856.04) and #17, and #25.
- Weyrlingassistant K'bort, rider of brown Jarvath (2855.05.08 -- present): K'bort joined the Weyrling Wing staff after losing his right arm during Threadfall. He served as Weyrlingsecond for Weyrling Classes #16, #22 & #29.
- Weyrlingassistant Kiriya, rider of green Caliath (2855.08.08 – 2856.04.15) Kiriya joined the Weyrling Wing when advancing pregnancy forced her out of the combat Wings. She served as weyrlingsecond for the first six months of WC #17 before returning to the combat Wings when her pregnancy was over, as soon as Weyrlingsecond B'baer was free to take over her class.
- Weyrlingassistant Ambri, rider of green Amaedanth (2856.01.01 -- present): Ambri transferred into the Weyrling Wing from Fort, and served as weyrlingsecond for Weyrling Class #19 and #23. She is now with class #31.
- Weyrlingassistant E'zok, rider of brown Struth (2857.02.01 -- present): a transferee into the Weyrling Wing from Ista, E'zok serves as one of two weyrlingseconds for Weyrling Class #24.
- Weyrlingassistant G'nán, rider of bronze Takarth (2857.06.28 – present). After his bronze Takarth had to have a badly burned wing amputated at the shoulder, G'nán was transferred to the Weyrling Wing. He met with some initial resentment because of his perceived role in Weyrwoman Tanara's breakup with D'zan; that event had resulted in hard times for all of D'zan's subordinates. He serves as one of two weyrlingseconds for Class #24.
- Weyrlingassistant Jallori, rider of brown Nusrath (2858.01.01 -- present). Jallori joined the Weyrling Wing staff after her dragon was partially blinded in one eye. She serves as weyrlingsecond for Class #28.
- Weyrlingassistant S'kan, rider of blue Raskath (2858.02.02 – present). S'kan transferred into the Weyrling Wing shortly after his transfer to Kadanzer from Fort Weyr. S'kan's easy-going, approachable, and sometimes non-confrontational personality makes him unusual within the Weyrling Wing staff. His first trials as weyrlingsecond will come with WC #30.
- Weyrlingassistant B'kuto (2859.02.15 – present). A native of Eastern Weyr, B'kuto transferred to Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning. B'kuto has served in StormWind, StarToucher & SkySoaring Wings; inherited his wingsecond position in StormWind from D'zan; and had served as wingsecond in SkyTamer since 2857.13.28, prior to his being transferred into the Weyrling Wing by Weyrleader L'ars, as part of L'ars's wingsecond restructuring effort.
- Wingsecond K'danag, rider of brown Quilloth (2859.02.15 – present). Another native of Landing, and son of Weyrsmith Kild, K'danag flew for a time with StarToucher, before transferring into FireStorm as junior wingsecond. He was transferred to the Weyrling Wing in 2859.02.15.
- Weyrlingassistant T'rynne, rider of brown Perinath (2859.02.15 – present); T'rynne transferred to Kadanzer from High Reaches Weyr after the Poisoning and served in FlameWind for nearly nine Turns, before he was transferred to the Weyrling Wing by Wingleader L'ars on 2859.02.15, as part of the Weyrleader's wingsecond restructuring effort.

- Goldrider Lauria, rider of gold Trinit (2851.01.01 – 2852.12.16); *please refer to Weyrwomen section at the top of the document.*
- Goldrider Kira, rider of gold Nanyth (2851 – 2854.04.15); *please refer to Weyrwomen section at the top of the document.*
- Goldrider Darby, rider of gold Evath (2852.05.17 – 2855.07.18); a native of Crackbone Creek Cothold in Cibola territory, and sister of brownrider D'zan. Evath died on the hatching sands of complications while laying her second clutch of eggs; Darby survived the loss and returned to her birthhold.
- Goldrider Valenne, rider of gold Nicareth (2853.08.11 – 2859.01.11); *please refer to Weyrwomen section at the top of the document.*
- Goldrider Kielani, rider of gold Virankath (2853.04.11 – 2858.03.06); *please refer to Weyrwomen section at the top of the document.*
- Goldrider Leddi, rider of gold Oroth (2854.03.01 – 2855.01.10) transferred in from High Reaches; a good friend of K'din's, she transferred back to the High Reaches with him at the end of his reign as Weyrleader.
- Goldrider Dunia, rider of gold Nioranth (2854.05.10 – present); Dunia is a native of Kadanzer Weyr.
- Goldrider Luka, rider of gold Savukath (2855.08.21 – present); Luka is a native of a small cothold in Cibola Hold's territory.
- Goldrider Cassidora, rider of gold Amisseth (2855.11.24 – present); Cassidora is a native of Riverdance Hold and was an apprentice dolphineer before Impression.
- Goldrider Zherra, rider of gold Velcroth (2857.13.24 – present); a native of Igen Weyr, Zherra and her family (including bronzerider Bh'ruk) transferred to Kadanzer Weyr after the Poisoning as replacement support staff.
- Goldrider Lybelle, rider of gold Ihyaniith (2858.03.06 – present); *please refer to Weyrwomen section at the top of the document.*
- Goldrider Faydra, rider of gold Ytrith (2858.07.05 – present); Faydra is a native of Cibola Hold, and was branded as a thief there before being brought to the Weyr.
- Goldrider Revanne, rider of gold Orylth (2859.02.14 – present); one of the time-traveling refugees from the Ninth Pass, Revanne and her weyrling gold were one of 11 weyrling dragonpairs of their weyrling class to survive to reach Kadanzer Weyr. Revanne is a no-nonsense woman who had earned her journeywoman smith knots before Impressing her part-Benden bloodline Orylth.



HEADWOMEN & HEADSECONDS:

Headwoman Vareina: (pre-Poisoning – 2850.09.13). The mother of greenriders Seina & Herala; we know nothing else about her, other than she was also an accomplished cook as well as Headwoman, and that she perished during the Poisoning.

Headwoman Lauria (2850.09.15 – 2850.11.01) Kadanzer's first wunderkind, a teenage Lauria served as the Headwoman until a replacement could be located.

Headwoman Raecliffe (2851.01.01 – 2850.11.01) Raecliffe transferred in to Kadanzer from Telgar to serve as Headwoman. Due to a prior head injury, she has a unique form of mental dysfunction and is unable to recognize people by their facial features. Nonetheless, she is extremely competent.

- Headsecond Bella, SkyHall Complex: (2856.04.15 – present) Bella transferred from Ista Weyr to Kadanzer Weyr on 2852.04.15, along with her children B'deras and Giselle. Bella openly dotes on B'deras, who can do no wrong and who has no peers (in her high opinion). She is recognized as an astutely capable woman, as well as the queen of the Weyr's gossip grapevine, which she is highly skilled at manipulating to her own purposes.
- Headsecond Catrel, Weyrcrafthall (2856.04.15 – present) a survivor of the Poisoning, Catrel is a lean, middle-aged man who is a skilled accountant. He's always been resentful of not having been made Headman of the Weyr after the Poisoning.
- Headsecond Danissa, WindHall Complex: (2856.04.15 – present) A native of Ista Weyr, Danissa is a close friend of Weyrwoman Valenne and fosters all of her children, as well as others. Danissa chose to stay on at Kadanzer after Valenne's transfer back to Ista in early 2859.
- Headsecond Lista, FireHall Complex (2856.04.15 – present) A native of Thornblaze Hold who transferred to the Weyr when her husband, bronzerider V'rili, was Searched. Has her own children as well as fosters.
- Headsecond Nacita, South Complex (2856.04.15 – present) A cheerful, plump weyrbred native of Kadanzer, Nacita has many fosterlings and is the mother or foster-mother of Alanna, N'dren, and others.
- Headsecond Rasha, Infirmary & Dragon Infirmary (2850.09.15 – present) a survivor of the Poisoning, Rasha has served as the Headsecond of the Infirmarys for Turns. She's also the guiding hand behind the Weyr's herbal garden. Mother of Meirel and sister of Journeywoman Kyrasia, foster-mother of Deza and others.
- Headsecond Resla, Weyrling Complex (2855.01.01 -- present) – first Headsecond of the Weyrling Wing & Candidate Barracks, Resla has held the position since her transfer to the Weyr from Kadanzer Hold.



CRAFTMASTERS OF KADANZER WEYR:

Dragonhealer

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*. Dragonhealers known to serve the Weyr during this time included Tanara, Katra and Casmir.
- Dragonhealer Giselle: (2852.04.15 – present) A native of Ista Weyr, Giselle transferred to Kadanzer along with her brother, Wingleader B'deras, and mother, Headsecond Bella, on 2852.04.15. She is fiercely dedicated to her craft.

Glowmaster

- *Glowmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*
- Glowmaster Farlow (2850.10 to present). A native of Kadanzer Hold, Farlow came to the Weyr shortly after the Poisoning and has served as the Weyr's glowmaster since. A Pollyanna fellow with a gift for gab; since learning to swim at the new Weyr, he even now takes dunks in the sea every night, meaning more of the Weyr's folk can appreciate this company.

Head Cook

- Head Cook Olversan (pre-Poisoning – 2850.09.12). A skilled cook who took great pride in his craft, Olversan died in the Poisoning.
- Head Cook Farny (2850.09.16 – present). The mother of Goldrider Dunia and Journeyman Petair, Farny is a survivor of the Poisoning. A skilled cook who enjoys gossip and good times, she is the current fostermother of D'zan and Tildy's daughter Marnia.

Weyrfarmer

- Weyrfarmer Raidun (2856.04.20 -- present) Raidun enjoys his craft, planting and caring for crops. An expert in the hybrid crops grown at the Weyr. Married to support staffer Fralla; their children are all grown. Note: there was no need for a WeyrFarmer until after the Weyr relocated to its new location.

Weyrglasscrafter

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*
- *Craftmaster unknown (2850.10.01 – 2856.04.16)* Deceased in the eruption of Mt. Kadanzer.
- *Craftmaster Affor (2856.04.20 – present)* A quiet, good-humored man, Affor was a native of Thornblaze Hold, and transferred to the Weyr along with his wife and three small children.

Weyrharper

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-Poisoning)* Harpers known to serve the Weyr in the first two Turns after the Poisoning included Journeyman Kiku and Apprentices Tori & Petair.
- *Craftmaster Andrian: (2851.13.10 – present).* A skilled diplomat and teacher, Andrian is a close friend of Masterharper Forelen, the father of Wingleader L'rian, and the weyrmate of Wingleader R'mal.

Weyrhealer

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-Poisoning);* all we know is that the craftmaster was male.
- *Journeyman Amano (2850-09.16 – 2854.01.28).* Journeyman healers who served the Weyr during this time included Amano, Betlor, Carran and Peregan. Amano is a friendly man who possesses an infectious good-nature and laid-back, soothing manner that serves him well as a healer. Father of Blue rider H'keo.
- *Weyrhealer Glynda (2854.02.01 – present).* A Kadanzer Weyr native, Glynda apprenticed with Northern craftmasters, and returned to Kadanzer after earning her craftmaster knots. Journeyman Amano stepped down from the position of Weyrhealer in her favor. Glynda is a calm, reserved, and authoritative woman; she is the sister of greenrider C'prio and the mother of daughters Tanvi and Kavita.

Weyrherder

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*
- *Craftmaster Namir (2850.10.01 – 2852.05.10)* The father of a Kadanzer blue rider, Namir requested a transfer to Kadanzer Weyr after the poisoning. He transferred out of the Weyr along with his son in 2852.05.10.
- *Craftmaster Rhiaf (2852.05.10 – 2852.05.12);* Namir's replacement was a very holderbred man who did not approve of weyrlife. Unfortunately, within days of his arrival, Rhiaf was gored to death by a marshland bull tithed by Lord Morgav
- *Craftmaster Marshall (2852.05.12 – present day).* A journeyman who was falsely accused of rape by a Lady Holder from Landing, Marshall was sent to Kadanzer Weyr by the strongly anti-Weyr Masterherder Jorel. After Rhiaf's death, Jorel refused to send a replacement; he has since been granted Marshall's craftmaster rank.

Weyrminer

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*
- *Craftmaster unknown (post-poisoning)*

Weyrpotter

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*
- *Craftmaster Bessami (2850.09.21– present)* A native of Landing Weyr, Bessami is a stubborn older woman who has no plans of ever retiring. Aunt of Greenrider Samara.

Weyrsmith

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)* We know there were two smithcrafters who died in the Poisoning (presumably one craftmaster and a journeyman); no mention is made of apprentices.
- *Craftmaster Polonal: (2850.10.01 – 2856.11.07)* Polonal came out of retirement after Turns of service at Sunstone Hold, in order to transfer to Kadanzer after the Poisoning. A genial, older man, his is still living at Kadanzer today as a retired crafter, and enjoys tinkering.
- *Craftmaster Kild (2856.11.07 – present)* A woodsmith by specialty, Craftmaster Kild distinguished himself in the building of the Weyr at its new tropical site. He was promoted as Weyrsmith in late 2856 upon Polonal's second retirement.

Weyrtailor

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*
- *Craftmaster unknown (2850.10.01 – 2855.01.01)*

- Craftmaster Madailyn (2855.01.01 – present) A quiet, friendly woman, Madailyn is a native of the Weavercraft Hall at Windsong Hold and transferred to Kadanzer after the death of her husband, a weaver, in a gather brawl. Earned her craftmaster knots shortly after her arrival at the Weyr.

Weyrtanner

- *Craftmaster unknown (pre-poisoning)*
- Craftmaster Majidi (2850.10.01 – present) A native of Eastern Weyr, Majidi works hard and expects the same from anyone under her. She is generally friendly and open, but can have a sharp tongue when annoyed.
